A GOLDEN SERVICE OPPORTUNITY:

Intergroup is an important service structure in our area.

Without it, AA wouldn't be as effective in getting the message out to alcoholics who still suffer in our area. Intergroup is essential to our continued sobriety and unity - connecting the groups in our area, making sure phones are answered, the website is kept up to date, and AA literature is widely available.

A position has opened up on Operating Committee. Gord S. resigned his position in March.

The election for a member on the 2021-2022 Operating Committee is taking place at the Intergroup meeting of **Tuesday, April 20th, 2021** at 7.30pm, at our online Intergroup Monthly meeting.

To be eligible, AA members need the following:

- Two years of continuous sobriety;
- Having served for one year as Intergroup representative, and/or
- Having served for one year on one of the Intergroup's sub-committees (Phones, Detox, Public Information etc).

As you know, the Operating Committee consists of ten people who meet once a month with the purpose of overseeing the operation of Intergroup and to ensure it is furthering AA's primary purpose. The commitment to the Operating Committee is for one year, requiring roughly two hours of meetings or work per week.

We hope you can pass along this message to those who could serve our area, while benefitting from the service of course! We hope to see as many strong candidates as possible on April 20th. A reminder that all AA members
