WHAT'S IT LIKE? AN OPERATIONG COMMITTEE NEWBIE SHARES HER EXPERIENCE:

Hi - I'm Lucie and I'm an alcoholic. I've been on our Intergroup's Operating Committee for the past six months. In a few words: it's been rewarding and I've learned a lot!

But let me back up a teeny bit. I have been sober a long time, and been an active member of the Lougheed Speaker Group since 1998. Throughout my sobriety, I've taken jobs at the group level and volunteered to answer the Intergroup phones.

Yet somehow, I have always shied away from stepping up to service positions beyond that. I know those areas are incredibly important to keep AA alive and kicking... But, like most of us, I told myself I was too busy etc etc.

When I retired in early 2019, I ran out of reasons. So I said 'yes' to my group selecting me as their Intergroup Rep. My awakening came when I realized how few people were willing to step up and serve a full term on the Operating Committee.

At the end of my year as Intergroup Rep, I simply had to put my hand up to help out. I'm so glad I did.

I am now way more aware of the fellowship beyond my group, and I have come to see what it takes to make sure our Intergroup office is supported to carry the message in our area in dozens of ways, including answering the phones and distributing the literature.

More than anything, I've got to know really inspiring fellow members, who show their gratitude by supporting our Intergroup. After all, Intergroup belongs to the fellowship - to all the groups in our area. We're all responsible for keeping the doors open.
